

# Access to the Venue

Please visit the website of your hotel to see their instructions on how to get there. Below are some maps of the Hongo campus and surrounding areas with locations of the Hotel Forest Hongo, the Hotel Coco Grand Ueno Shinobazu and the Keisei line Ueno station and the JR line Ueno station. In addition, instructions on how to get from the Narita airport and the Haneda airport to the Ueno and Tokyo stations using either an express train or limousine bus are provided below. Please note that the Conference organizers will not arrange a pick-up service at the airport.







## 1. Access from the Narita Airport

# A. To the **Ueno station** (closest to the venue, Forest Hongo Hotel and Hotel Coco Grand Ueno Shinobazu):

Take the <u>Keisei line Skyliner</u> train from the Nartita airport to the Ueno station and either walk (20 min to the venue, 5 min to the Coco Grand Hotel, 25 min to the Forest Hongo Hotel) or take a taxi. *Time required: 40 min Fare: 2470 JPY* 



## B. To the Tokyo station

(a) Take the JR Narita Express (N'EX) Train from the airport to the Tokyo station.

Time required: 60 min

Fare: 3020 JPY (1500 JPY for foreign-passport holders – <u>N'EX Tokyo Direct Ticket</u>)



(b) Take the <u>Airport Limousine Bus</u> to the <u>Tokyo station</u>. *Time required: 75 - 125 min Fare: 3000 JPY* 

## 2. Access from the Haneda Airport


#### A. To the Tokyo station

(a) Take the <u>Airport Limousine Bus</u> to the <u>Tokyo station</u>. *Time required: 30 - 45 min Fare: 900 JPY* 

(b) Take the **Tokyo Monorail** line to the **Hamamatsucho** station (terminal) and change to the **JR Yamanote line inner loop**, direction to the **Tokyo** station. Please visit the <u>Tokyo Monorail Line Web</u> for detailed instructions on how to use the Tokyo Monorail and JR lines to get to the Tokyo station.

(c) Take the **Keikyu line** to the **Shinagawa** station, change to the **JR Yamanote line inner loop**, direction to the **Tokyo** station. Please visit the <u>Keikyu Line Web</u> for detailed instructions on how to use the Keikyu and JR lines to get to the Tokyo station.

#### B. To the Ueno station

Take either the Keikyu line or Tokyo Monorail line and follow the instructions above on how to get to the Tokyo station. Do not get off at the Tokyo station and continue to ride on the JR Yamanote line inner loop up to the Ueno station. Please note that the JR Ueno station is not identical with the Kesei Ueno station but it is located very close. Refer to the Ueno and Hongo Campus area map above.

Also please visit the <u>Keikyu Line Web</u> and <u>Tokyo Monorail Line Web</u> for detailed instructions on how to use the Keikyu or Tokyo Monorail lines and JR lines to get to the Ueno station.

#### Recommended access to the Hotel Coco Grand Ueno Shinobazu and Hotel Forest Hongo:

- 1. Hotel Coco Grand Ueno Shinobazu:
  - from Narita: use the Keisei Skyliner to the Keisei Ueno and then walk (~300m) to your hotel
  - from Haneda: see the instructions above to get to the JR Ueno station and then walk (~500m) or take a taxi to your hotel
- 2. Hotel Forest Hongo:
  - from Narita: use the Keisei Skyliner to the Keisei Ueno and then take a taxi (about 2000 JPY) or walk to your hotel (~2km)
  - from Haneda: see the instructions above to get to the Tokyo station, change there to the Tokyo Metro Marunouchi line and go to the Hongo-sanchome station. Take a taxi or walk (~1km) to your hotel. You can also take a taxi from the Tokyo station, it takes about 20 minutes and costs 2500 JPY.
