What's NARBO?

- ✓ Network of Asian River Basin Organization was initiated by Asian Development Bank (ADB), ADB Institute (ADBI) and Japan Water Agency (JWA).
- ✓ Formally announced by signing the LOI on March 21, 2003, during the 3rd World Water Forum at Kyoto-Shiga, Japan.
- ✓ Established on February 24-26, 2004 in Malang, Indonesia





Our Goal

To help to achieve IWRM in river basins throughout Asia.

[Definition of IWRM]

IWRM is "a process which promotes the coordinated development and management of water, land and related resources, in order to maximize the resultant economic and social welfare in an equitable manner without compromising the sustainability of vital ecosystems."

(Defined by the Technical Committee of the Global Water Partnership)



Objective

To strengthen the capacity and effectiveness of RBOs in promoting IWRM and improving water governance, through training & exchange of information and experiences among RBOs and their water sector agencies & knowledge partner organizations.

For RBO's sustainability, the fittest model can survive. If the RBO is not fit for the purpose, it will die. At the same time, you need to look at financial side. Without money, nothing can move. And, it depends on national policies. There us 'no one size fits all'. Don't think that there is one solution for you. Ultimately, each RBO is unique. You have to learn from others but you have to come up with your own model. Hopefully, you will share your experience with NARBO so that our members can have more models to choose from.








Result of NARBO Activities
