Formatting/MPI Issues

- Model center online documentation should be brought up to date at both UCAR and MPI
- Code Tables for Grib
 - Every institution will, at some time provide a code table to MPI when/if grib data are uploaded
- Continue to encourage users to interact with the MPI database and provide feedback to MPI
- MPI is looking for resources to provide more convenient (for Users) data files

Model Intercomparison
