On behalf of the World Climate Research Programme (WCRP) Global Energy and Water Cycle Experiment (GEWEX) Coordinated Energy and Water Cycle Observations Project (CEOP), I invite you to participate in the next CEOP International Implementation Planning Meeting, which will be held in Geneva, Switzerland, 15–17 September 2008, chaired by Dr. Toshio Koike (University of Tokyo). The Meeting is being hosted by the WCRP Secretariat at the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Headquarters building, located in Geneva, Switzerland. Support for the meeting is also being provided by the U.S. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), the U.S. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA), and the University of Tokyo. A task team has developed a draft Strategic Implementation Plan (SIP) with the overall science objectives and structure for CEOP. It is expected that the plan will be finalized in Geneva and the new CEOP Science Advisory Group (SAG) will lead discussions on how to gain the interest of other international organizations, including the Global Earth Observation Systems (GEOSS).

The meeting will be held at the WMO building (7 bis, Avenue de la Paix, Case Postale 2300, 1211 Geneva 2, Switzerland); room blocks for the period of 13–18 September 2008 have been arranged by WCRP. Details for making reservations at the hotels and arriving at the meeting venue as well as other logistics associated with this important event will be provided to you soon.
